WHAT IS PRESSURE MAPPING?

Pressure Mapping measures the interface pressure between a support surface and its user. At Forté Healthcare we use the Tekscan Pressure Measurement System which utilises a thin and flexible sensor. We use this system to measure the pressure distribution of a human body on the surface of our mattresses with minimal interference.

The images on the left demonstrate the pressure distribution of a 98kg male over a 6-hour period, shown in a variety of positions on the 'Medium Icon Homecare Mattress'.

Pressure Mapping aids us in the Research & Development of our products, allowing a close insight into areas of peak pressure on the body. Counter-control measures can therefore be taken to ensure peak pressures are successfully redistributed, thus mitigating the risk of pressure injuries.

Pressure Mapping is a commonly used tool in attaining clinical data on interface pressures, however Forté Healthcare acknowledges *"it cannot be used to conclude on internal stresses and the stress concentration levels in deep vascularized tissues, particularly muscles."*^[1]

The example pressure mapping provided by Forté Healthcare is only intended for use as a clinical aid, *"rather than a replacement to clinical judgement."*^[2]



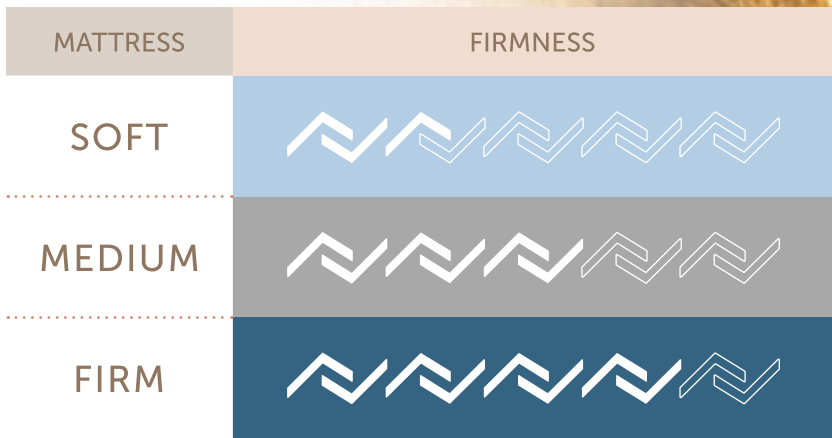
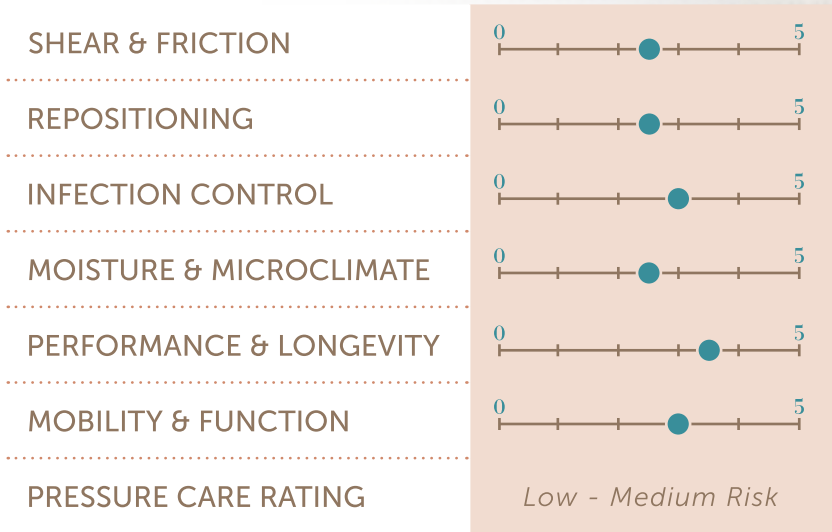
